CELEBRATING SIBELIUS IN 2015

Next year marks the 150th anniversary of the birth of legendary Finnish composer Jean Sibelius (1865-1957). To mark the anniversary, numerous special events will be held in Helsinki throughout the year. Helsinki is filled with memories of Sibelius. Places connected to his life include the Great Hall of the University of Helsinki, the Esplanade and Kallio Cathedral. The most important places and moments in the life of the composer have been collected together to form a travel route that reflects his path through life. The Path of Sibelius also provides an opportunity to catch a glimpse of Sibelius-era Finland, its colorful history and the landscapes that inspired the composer. In the 1880s the island was used by the Russian Navy to store mines, in the 1920s it was used as a base for clearing mines, and in the post-war period ships were demagnetized there. 



OLYMPIC STADIUM

The World Gymnaestrada lasts for seven days including the Opening and Closing Ceremonies. The World Gymnaestrada week will be full of performances and demonstrations from the entire range of Gymnastics for All, exclusive of competitions. Changes are still possible. Rehearsal times will be communicated later.

Wednesday Special Large Group Day Registrations must be made through the FIG Member Federations. This program is in accordance with the FIG-GfA Regulations Manual, edition 2009. Please note that participants under the age of 16 should be organised into groups of up to ten (10) and placed in the care of an adult identified by name.

OPENING CEREMONY

At the Olympic Stadium on Sunday July 12 at 16:00 (duration max. 2 hours)
Theme: Make the Earth Move

The Opening Ceremony will start with the marching in of the World Gymnaestrada participants and everyone is welcome to take part. You can also choose to watch the marching in from the stands (you will be informed about seating in advance). Federations are kindly asked to estimate the number of their participants marching in, and the number of participants watching the marching in by December 31.

Please, give us your estimation on extranet (see: wg-2015.com/extranet/programme/ openingceremony)

Several sports fields will be used for gathering, which starts at 14:00. The length of the marching/ walking route will be no more than one kilometer. Each country will follow their national flag and name board. Federations are asked to name the person carrying the national flag. Gymnasts taking part in the marching in must wear their national clothing/ tracksuit, and behaving appropriately and according to the instructions provided by the organizers. Let's make this an athletic, cheerful marching in with a great feeling. After the marching, all participants will go to their allocated seats to watch the ceremony. After the Opening Ceremony the Get Together area will be open.

CLOSING CEREMONY

At the Olympic Stadium on Saturday July 18, at 15:00 (duration max. 1½ hours)

The World Gymnaestrada 2015 will end with a festive show. The Local Organising Committee is keeping the program of this ceremony secret.

Some gymnastics will be seen, such as the Gymnaestrada World Team (International Large Group Program).

MIDNIGHT SUN SPECIAL -EVENING FOR LARGE GROUP PERFORMANCES

At the Olympic Stadium on Wednesday July 15 at 21:00 (duration app. 1½ hours)

Idea: In Finland the sun shines throughout the whole night at midsummer and we have lots of energy and fun because of it. Let's all enjoy it and really move the Earth. Theme: We make the Earth move under the Midnight Sun with the joy and energy of Large Group Performances. This evening is for Large Group Performances, and it is included in the Participant card.

We will see programs from Denmark, Finland, Germany, Norway, Portugal, Slovakia and Switzerland. We will also see the very first Gymnaestrada World Team program here.

REHEARSALS SCHEDULE

Each program: one hour on Tuesday or Wednesday (you will be informed of the schedule later). Final dress rehearsal for all programs and all gymnasts on Wednesday at 18:00 – 19:30. All music via Gymnaplana by May 31, at the latest.

GROUP PERFORMANCES

At the Messukeskus Expo and Convention Centre, July 13 – 17, daily at 09:00 – 18:00

Groups shall comprise no less than ten active performers. Performances shall be indoors on three occasions. Duration of each performance is either 10 or 15 minutes, max. Measurements: Amfi-hall (Helsinki hall) 40 m x 20 m, one arena size 40 m x 20 m, seven arenas size 20 m x 20 m. Groups are invited backstage 45 minutes before their performance time. All music via Gymnaplana by May 31, at the latest.

LARGE GROUP PERFORMANCES

At Sonera Stadium, July 14 - 17, in the afternoons, duration max. 15 minutes, shown three times throughout the week.

Large Groups shall comprise of no less than 200 active performers/gymnasts. All music via Gymnaplana by May 31, at the latest.

NATIONAL EVENINGS

At the Ice Hall on July 13, 14 and 16

Rehearsal schedules have been sent to the relevant Federations. Tickets for the National Evenings are not included in the Participant card. Federations can book tickets for their participants until December 31, via Gymnaplana. However, tickets cannot be guaranteed, as numbers are limited. 



Each group has the opportunity to perform one to three times (max. 3 performances) depending on requests. The LOC reserves the right to make changes.



TÖÖLÖ SPORTS HALL

During the World Gymnaestrada this venue will be used for different kinds of gymnastics activities. Also the venue for youth evening program (Sunday, Wednesday, Saturday).



QUIPMENT / APPARATUS

The main partner for gymnastics equipment is Kerko Sport Oy (Kerko).

Kerko will provide the equipment in cooperation with Janssen-Fritsen Gymnastics BV (JF), Eurotramp-Trampoline Kurt Hack GmbH (Eurotramp) and Linden Equipment for Gymnastics AB (LEG).

The list of apparatus provided by the LOC is listed in Bulletin 3.

Gymnastics apparatus will be provided free of charge up to certain limit for Group Performances, National Afternoons, National Evenings, FIG Gala, City Performances (1 stage) and Large Group Performances.

All apparatus must be ordered separately including roll mats (14 x 2 m) for Group Performances. The order must be made through the Gymnaplana registration system by the deadline of December 31.

Storage places for delegation-specific apparatus will be provided. However, delegations are responsible for taking care of the transportation of their apparatus.

If delegations are using apparatus that are the products of companies other than our partners, all visible logos and other company identifiers must be covered during performances (e.g. with tape).

ARRIVAL AND DEPARTURE DETAILS

Please, inform us of your travel details (date, time and flight number for arrival and departure), and order transportation via Gymnaplana right after you have received information about your school, and by the end of February at the latest. For all orders made after February 28 the LOC cannot guarantee transportation to your designated accommodation.

WELCOME DESKS AT HELSINKI AIRPORT

HOW TO USE A PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION CARD (HSL TRANSPORT CARD)

The head of delegation is responsible for delivering HSL transport cards to participants upon arrival. Participants will need the HSL transport cards when they plan to use public transportation to travel to their accommodation sites. Please remember to keep the HSL transport card with you during the event. You need to show it to electronic admission devices in buses, trains, trams and metro.

AREA COVERED BY PARTICIPANT CARD

The Participant card with an HSL transport card is valid for free-of-charge public transport between your official accommodation and the venues. If your official accommodation is in Helsinki, the HSL transport card is valid in Helsinki. If your official accommodation is in Espoo or Vantaa, the HSL transport card is valid in Helsinki, Espoo and Vantaa. If a participant has made their own bookings for accommodation, the HSL transport card is valid in Helsinki

ARRIVING WITH YOUR OWN VEHICLES

We strongly advise participants to use public transportation during the event. There is a parking-building next to Messukeskus Expo and Convention Centre for private cars (11 euro/day in 2014). The LOC will point out parking place for buses near to Messukeskus Expo and Convention Centre. The drop-off places next to the venues are exclusively for WG2015 vehicles.

DEPARTURE AFTER GYMNAESTRADA

LOC will provide detailed departure lists to schools and hotels for those who have ordered transportation from LOC via Gymnaplana. Lists will be distributed two to three days before departure. From the list, participants may check their departure time from their accommodation. This will be approx. three hours before flight time.

CATERING

MORNINGS

Breakfast is included in the school accommodation (eight basic breakfasts from Sunday to Sunday). Breakfast time is from 6:30 to 9:00 at schools. No takeaways - eating at tables only. Hot/cold drinks, bread, cheese, yogurt, fruit. Hotels normally include breakfast (check this).

MIDDAY

Participants have an opportunity to purchase a lunch-package (seven lunches). The lunch-package costs 100 euro per participant (seven lunches from Sunday July 12 to Saturday 18). Lunches take place in the Messukeskus Expo and Convention Centre, Hall 3 between 11:00 – 15:00. Each day there is a "basic menu" and a "vegetarian menu". The vegetarian menu needs to be ordered at the same time as the Definitive Registration and is ordered for the whole week. Preliminary menus can be found from the extranet. Final menus will be published in the Bulletin 5.

EVENINGS

In the evenings, everyone can purchase food at the World Gymnaestrada Get Together Area next to the Olympic Stadium. This is the place to go for having a good time together with other participants. For those who wish to visit the city, Helsinki is full of restaurants offering flavors from all over the world.

ACCOMMODATION

SCHOOL ACCOMMODATION

The schools are located within a 16-kilometer radius, in the cities of Helsinki, Espoo and Vantaa. Locations are a maximum of 30 minutes walking distance or a maximum of 30 minutes travel by public transport. The official arrival days are

Saturday July 11 and Sunday July 12, and the official departure days Saturday July 18 and Sunday July 19.

Allocation will be based on the number of Definitive Registrations (December 2014). The Federations will be informed of the schools at the beginning of 2015. Note that it is each Federation's responsibility to allocate the schools for clubs and participants, and also specify classrooms for the clubs via Gymnaplana.

Schools are for sleeping and for breakfasts – not for party, cooking, smoking or consumption of alcohol. School rules will be published on the web pages.

EXTRA NIGHTS ONLY ON SPECIAL REQUEST

Extra nights at schools at an extra charge can be arranged for a limited number of participants. Priority will be given for groups arriving from the furthest away, and for the largest delegations. Extra nights only on special request; for requests contact the office@wg-2015.com. Extra night costs: 35 euro/night/person (including light breakfast).

Note that the school for an extra night might be different from the one where the participant is staying for the World Gymnaestrada week. The participant might need to move to another school (with the participant card, or at her/his own expense).

Important: the maximum width of the mattress used in the schools is 80 cm for security and safety reasons.

HOTEL ACCOMMODATION

Hotel rooms for participants are booked via Confedent International Ltd. The booking of rooms has started and the request of an offer form can be found in Gymnaplana (log in to the Federation's extranet Gymnaplana). Make your hotel reservations now.

OFFICIAL HOTEL

The Official Hotel is Holiday Inn Helsinki Messukeskus Expo & Convention Centre. Federations were able to request the number of rooms from the LOC via Gymnaplana until November 1. Each Federation has had the possibility to book rooms based on the size of the delegation.

The LOC will confirm these rooms for the Federations during November. The number of rooms can be changed if the Definitive Registration is significantly different from the Preliminary Registrations. The charges for these rooms will be included in your overall invoice.

Official hotel guests must be assigned and allocated to the rooms by April 8. Allocating participants/guests will be done via Gymnaplana.

The minimum period for reservations is July 11 – 19. Extra nights are possible on request, depending on other bookings.

SECURITY

The overall security situation in Finland is stable and calm. The LOC will work in close cooperation with the local authorities. A private security company will have the operative responsibility for security during the event.

The LOC reminds participants to take care of their belongings and not to leave them unguarded in

public places. Pickpockets operate in locations populated by tourists in broad daylight.

SECURITY IN SCHOOLS

All schools are located in residential areas. The normal rhythm of life goes on around the schools: people going to work, shopping, jogging and sleeping. At least two school hosts will be present at every school at all times. They are well briefed and trained. They are familiar with the building and its technical properties.

School hosts always occupy the entrance to schools. Schools hosts will check access rights. Only those who are accommodated in the school are allowed to enter. The Federations official staff has the access to schools of their delegation. There will be only one entrance to each school. All other doors will be locked from the outside. In case of emergency, school hosts will make contact with the relevant emergency services for their immediate assistance.

MEDICAL SERVICES

Every World Gymnaestrada venue will have a first aid service run by the LOC and the Finnish Red Cross.

The main first aid station will be at Messukeskus Expo and Convention Centre.

OTHER FIRST AID STATIONS WILL BE AT:

- Olympic Stadium
- Helsinki Ice Hall
- Sonera Stadium

The city performance stages will have mobile first aid units run by the Finnish Red Cross. First aid facilities are marked with a Red Cross or white cross on a green background. Operating times will follow scheduled rehearsal times and the official program.

All schools will have information on medical services nearby. School hosts will help with any situation in an emergency.

In case of a real emergency you can also dial 112 (no area or national codes). You will be provided with first aid guidance and directed to a suitable health care destination. Local paramedics and first response units are all professionals. Local and university hospitals/health care stations operate 24 hours a day. Private health care stations and hospitals are also very close by and are easily accessible.

It is important that you hold valid travel insurance and have your personal documents with you and when entering a hospital abroad. Different documents are needed for different nationalities (EU and EEA vs. non-EU) - make sure you check these before leaving home. Take your medication and prescriptions with you (it is also recommended to have a list of any medication, including the names of active ingredients rather than product names) as most medication requires a Finnish or European prescription in Finland when purchasing it at a pharmacy.

CONSULTATION ROOMS FOR DELEGATIONS' MEDICAL TEAMS

If your delegation would like to have a consultation room for your own medical team, please contact the LOC/office. Rooms can be arranged at the Messukeskus Expo and Convention Centre. Price is determined by the time of use.

INSURANCE

Everyone must have insurance that covers medical costs abroad and for events. This is obligatory for all participants. It can be either your own insurance or insurance ordered from the LOC. Your own insurance: If you purchase insurance in your own country, you must inform us of the name of the

insurance company and the insurance number via Gymnaplana.

INSURANCE ORDERED FROM LOC, BY EU-ROOPPALAINEN INSURANCE COMPANY LTD.:

Duration of stay in Finland max 9 days (July 11 – 19, 2015): price 30 euro per person. Duration of stay in Finland max 16 days: price 40 euro per person.

The insurance covers medical treatment expenses incurred in Finland as a result of travel illness or travel accident during the period of validity of the insurance. Medical treatment expenses are covered up to a maximum of 8.500 euro. The insurance is subject to the Foreign Citizen travel insurance terms (see Extranet). Note that this Foreign Citizen insurance is valid only in Finland and covers medical treatment administered in Finland. The insurance is not valid in competitive sports or in training for competitive sports. Please, note that this insurance also covers reasonable and necessary repatriation and medical evacuation expenses subject to advance approval by Eurooppalainen Insurance Company Ltd. The insurance can be ordered via Gymnaplana in connection with the Definitive Registration.

We would still like to emphasize that insurance which covers medical costs abroad and for events is obligatory for all participants.

ENTERING FINLAND – VISAS

VISA REQUIREMENT AND TRAVEL DOCU-MENTS

Note that visas need to be applied for well in advance. Federations are responsible for taking care of their delegations' visa requirements and travel documents. 
