## QUALIFYING COMPETITION

#### Seniors - Qualifying Competition incl. All-Around Final, plus qualification for Apparatus Finals and Team Final

A Senior team consists of 3 - 5 gymnasts, of which up to 4 compete on each apparatus. The 3 best scores on each apparatus are added together to make the total score for the Team on that apparatus. MAG Federations who compete with a Senior Team may bring a 6th gymnast to participate as an individual apparatus specialist. This gymnast may compete on a maximum of 3 apparatus. The apparatus on which the 6th gymnast competes must be declared in the confirmation of starting order. The 6<sup>th</sup> gymnast will compete with the team, always as the last gymnast on the apparatus.

If a Federation does not have a sufficient number of gymnasts for a full team, it is possible to participate with Individual gymnasts.

A separate All-Around Final result list will be produced including the 24 gymnasts with the highest ranking obtained. A maximum of 2 gymnasts per Federation will be taken into consideration.

The results from the Senior Qualifying competition will determine the All-Around Senior European Artistic Gymnastics Champion 2024.
